2. if you're in the library, simply click on the database of your choice

Login to WYLD Licensed Databases

WYLD licenses numerous databases for the exclusive use of Wyoming citizens. The vendors of these products require that every user **must be authenticated before access is permitted.**

To authenticate your access to these databases, enter your 14 digit WYLD library card number and your PIN and then click on [Authenticate](#).

This login will permit you to search as many databases as desired until you close your browser.

14 digit Library Card number
e.g. 29092005555555
TIP: do not enter any letters or spaces that may appear on the card before or after the number.
2. **AND your Library PIN** [Request my PIN](#)
3. then click on

4. enter your library card number and PIN (unless you've changed it, it should be WYLD), press "Authenticate" . . .
5. and presto, you'll be taken to the database of your choice
