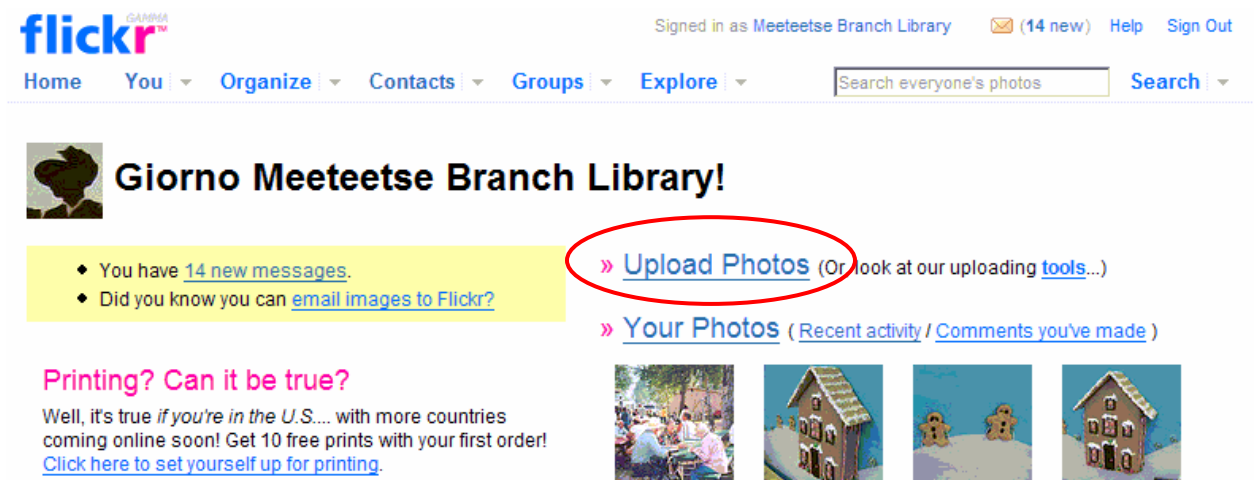
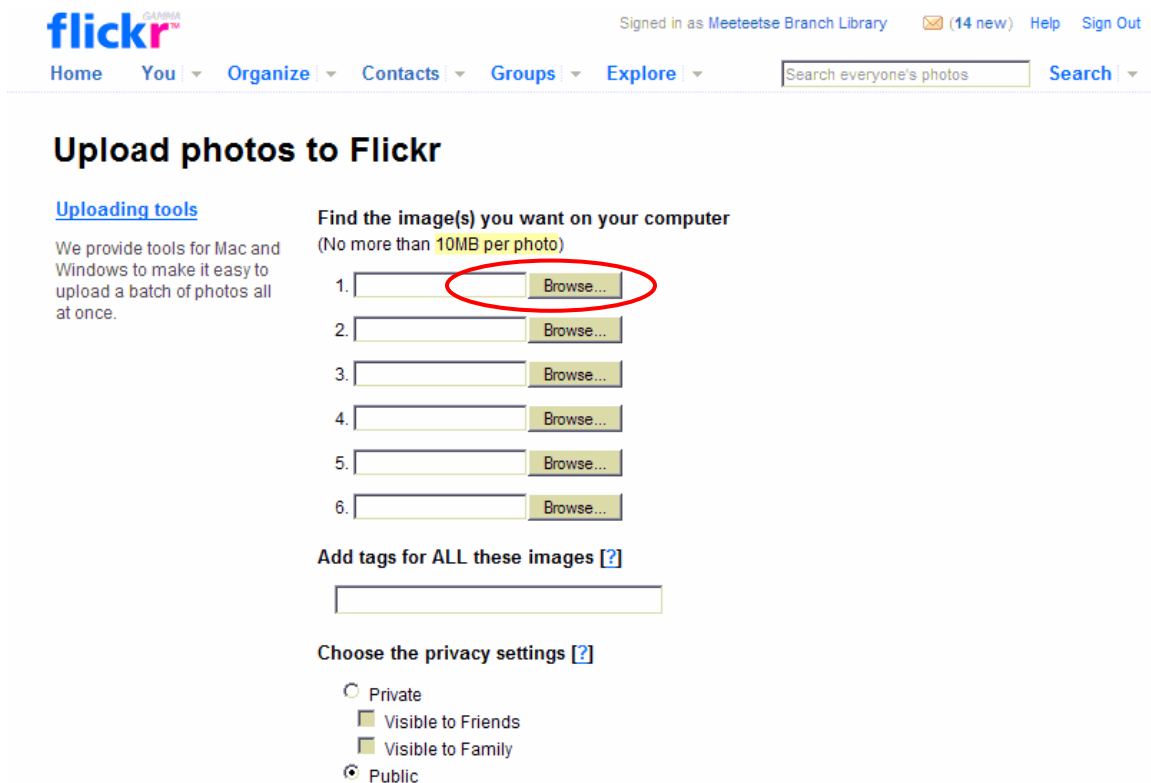


HOW TO UPLOAD PHOTOS ON FLICKR

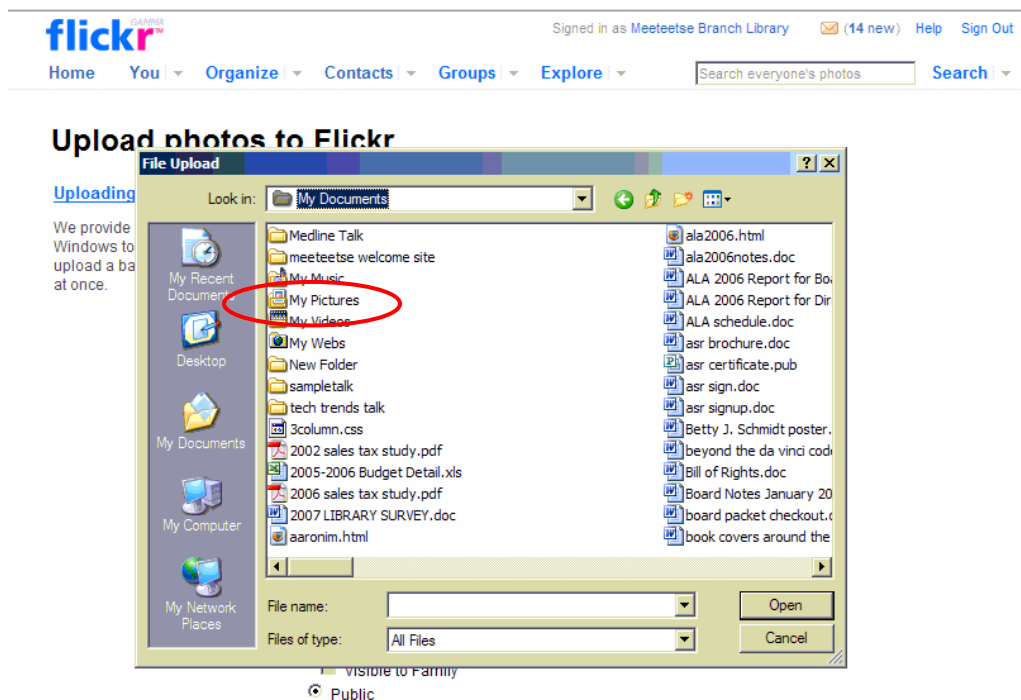
1. Login to your Flickr account. Click on Upload Photos.



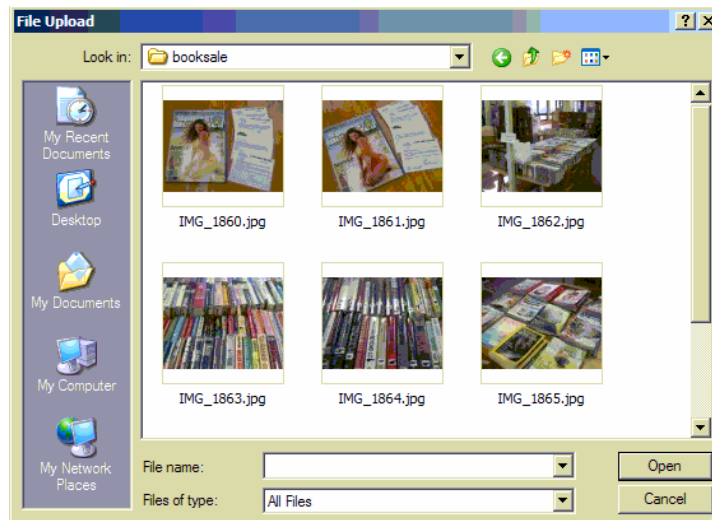
2. You'll get a screen that looks like this. Click on one of the Browse buttons.



3. That will bring up a window showing the contents of your computer. Open the folder where the pictures you want to upload are stored. (Chances are good that they will be in My Pictures, though you may have put them somewhere else).



4. When you find a picture you want to upload, click on it and then click Open (or double click on the picture, or click on the picture and hit enter).



5. That will take you back to the uploading page. If you have more photos to upload, click on the next Browse button and repeat steps 2 - 4.

Uploading tools

We provide tools for Mac and Windows to make it easy to upload a batch of photos all at once.

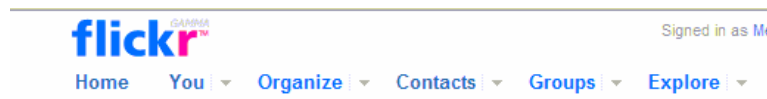

6. When you've finished, just click the blue button at the bottom that says UPLOAD. Flickr will let you know that it's uploading your pictures and processing them in different sizes. I usually go check my e-mail or something for a few minutes while this is going on.

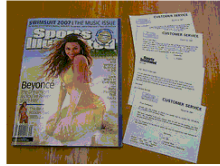
Please leave this window open while the upload process completes. Meanwhile, feel free to open a new browser window and continue using Flickr.
